

STATEMENT: NAPLES ROUNDTABLE RECOMMENDS SUSPENSION OF PATENT OFFICE RELATIONSHIPS WITH AGGRESSOR STATES

Released: March 4, 2022

The Naples Roundtable, a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization whose primary mission is to explore ways to improve and strengthen the U.S. patent system, issued the following statement regarding Russia's invasion of Ukraine:

The Naples Roundtable condemns Russia's illegal and unprovoked war against Ukraine. The Naples Roundtable applauds the decision of the European Patent Office (EPO) to "freeze [its] co-operation activities with the national patent offices of the Federation of Russia and of Belarus, as well as to put on hold [its] co-operation activities with the Eurasian Patent Organisation."

The Naples Roundtable also supports the decision of the U.S. Patent & Trademark Office (USPTO) to "terminate[] engagement with officials from Russia's agency in charge of intellectual property" (Rospatent) "and with Eurasian Patent Organization."

The Naples Roundtable encourages the USPTO to add the national patent office of Belarus to its engagement freeze, and to consider the following further actions to the extent permitted under international treaty and multi-lateral agreement obligations:

- terminate the agreement between the USPTO and Rospatent under which Rospatent functions as an International Searching Authority (ISA) and International Preliminary Examining Authority under the Patent Cooperation Treaty for international applications filed with the USPTO.³
- remove all USPTO webpages and information sheets⁴ instructing applicants to transmit money to Russia's Central Bank and to Russia's VTB Bank, or to any other sanctioned bank, in connection with the payment of fees to Rospatent.
- suspend all participation by the USPTO under any and all Patent Prosecution Highway (PPH) pilot programs between Rospatent and the USPTO, including by

refusing to grant any request which designates Rospatent as the office of earlier examination (OEE).⁵

- remove all USPTO webpages containing forms for applicants to request participation in the PPH pilot program between Rospatent and the USPTO.⁶
- urge all participating offices of the Global PPH to suspend Rospatent's participation in the Global PPH pilot program, including by refusing to grant any request which designates Rospatent as the OEE.⁷
- suspend all examiner exchanges, capacity building programs, and other cooperation agreements with the national patent offices of the Federation of Russia and of Belarus and the Eurasian Patent Organization.
